

## Halloween Spider

Of course you need a crochet spider to scare your friends when they come over for halloween dinner!

## Materials

Any small amount of black thread with a crochet hook of suitable size.
I used cotton thread to go with Boye crochet needle size 6, and the spider was 4 cm (1,57") long.
You will need 1 black or striped pipecleaner and two beads for eyes.
Abbreviations US
sl st = slip stitch
$\mathrm{sc}=$ single crochet (UK double crochet=dc)
ch = chain tog = together
nxt $=$ next st $=$ stitch
skip $=$ UK miss

## Head:

Round 1: 6 sc in a magic circle $=6 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 2: 2 sc in each st around $=12 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 3-4: 1 sc in each st around $=12 \mathrm{sc}$ ( 24 sc in total). Round 5: 2 sc tog 6 times $=6 \mathrm{sc}$
Stuff the head with fiberfill or left over thread.

## Body:

Round 6: In the front loop: 1 sc in each st around $=6 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 7: 2 sc in each st around $=12 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 8: 1 sc in each st around $=12 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 9: ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the nxt st) 6 times $=18 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 10-11: 1 sc in each st around= 18 sc ( 36 sc in total).
Round 12: ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog) 6 times $=12 \mathrm{sc}$.
Stuff the body with fiberfill or left over thread.
Round 13: $(2 \mathrm{sc}$ tog) 6 times $=6 \mathrm{sc}$.
Finish with 1 sl st, cut the thread and fasten off.


## Finishing:

Make a hole between the head and the body by using a knitting needle or a crochet hook. Cut the pipe cleaner into four pieces and insert them into the hole.

Shape the legs and sew the eyes onto the head.
