

# **DOLL DRESS MODEL 1**



Material:

DMC cotton thread, size 10. Crochet hook Boye size 8 Size: The dress will fit a crochet doll approx 11 cm (4 1/3') tall.

To fit a smaller doll the thread can be replaced by DMC 20 and a hook size 11.

tog = together

skip = UK miss

st = stitch

nxt = next

#### Abbreviations: ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch sc = single crochet (UK double crochet=dc) hdc = half double crochet (UK half treble crochet=htr) dc = double crochet (UK treble crochet=tr)

#### Buttons:

Buttons doesn't have to be miniature buttons, they can be hard to come by. It can just as easily and better be little pearls of a fitting size. If you can't find the right color, a transparant button/bead can be used instead.

#### Button hole:

The size of the button hole depends on the size of the button/bead. One chain for each millimeter will be just right, so if the button is 4 mm across, use chain 4. In these patterns I have consequently used 4 mm buttons and chain 4 for each button hole. If you have another sized button, please adjust this. Note!

### Each row starts with:

Ch 1 if the first stitch is a single crochet (not counted as one)

- Ch 2 if the first stitch is a half doube crochet
- Ch 3 if the first stitch is a double crochet

The dress is crocheted from the waist up, continues along the side and is then crocheted from the waist down.

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  - (1 sc, 1 dc) to the end of the row, begin in the 2nd st from the hook = 28 st
    - (1 sc, 1 dc) 3 times, Ch 6, skip 3 st, (1 dc, 1 sc) 5 times, Ch 6, skip 3 st, (1 sc, 1 dst) 3 times = 34
- Ch 4 = the first button hole. Crochet 2 sc along the side of the dress in row 5 and 4.

Continue with one of the variants below and finish the dress. Fasten off and sew on two tiny buttons.

#### Variant 1 - Yellow dress

Row 8-13

\*(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in the next st, skip 1 st\*, repeat \*\* to end of row = 14 groups.

For a wider dress, crochet 3 dc instead of 2 dc.



#### Variant 2 - Green dress

\*3 dc in the next st, 1 sc\* repeat \*\* to end of row.

Row \*(Ch 3, skip 1 st, 1 sc in the next st)\* repeat \*\* to end of row. 9-17



### Variant 3 - Peach dress

row)\* repeat \*\* to end of row

\*3 dc in the next st, ch 2, skip 1 st\*, repeat \*\* to end of row. = 14 groups

Ch 3, \*(1 sc in the second dc on the previous row, 3 dc in the sc from the previous

End each row with a slip stitch in the last ch of the previous row.

Row	
1	Ch 29. Leave a long tail that can be used later for sewing on the buttons.
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- 2-6 7

Ch 4 = the second button hole. Crochet 1 sc in the last st from the first row. From now on the work continues from the waist down.
