



# Small crochet bunny

This cute little bunny is not too difficult to make and will look great as a luck charm on your child's school bag!

## Abbreviations

sl st = slip stitch	tog = together
sc = single crochet (UK double crochet=dc)	st = stitch
hdc = half double crochet (UK half treble crochet=htr)	ch = chain
dc = double crochet (UK treble crochet=tr)	next = next

## Crochet together:

Crochet together is done by crocheting the first and last st with 1 sc, the second and penultimate st with 1 sc and so on. You will end up with half as many stitches left as you had before.

### Arm (make 2)

- Round 1: Ch 4, 1 sc in the second st from the hook, 2 sc. Crochet around on the other side 3 sc = 6
- Round 2: (2 sc in the next st, 2 sc) 2 times = 8
- Round 3: (2 sc in the next st, 3 sc) 2 times = 10
- Round 4: (2 m tog, 3 sc) 2 times = 8
- Round 5: (2 sc tog, 2 sc) 2 times = 6
- Round 6-10: 1 sc in each st around = 6 (30 in total)
- Crochet sc to a new position on the side of the arm. Fill the arm with fiberfill, flatten it and crochet it together with 3 sc. Cut the thread and pull it through the last st. Put it aside for later.

### Leg (make 2)

- Round 1: Ch 5, 1 sc in the second ch from the hook, 4 sc. Crochet around on the other side 4 sc = 8
- Round 2: (2 sc in the next st, 3 sc) 2 times = 10
- Round 3: (2 sc in the next st, 4 sc) 2 times = 12
- Round 4: 1 sc in each st around = 12
- Round 5: (2 m tog, 4 sc) 2 times = 10
- Round 6: (2 m tog, 3 sc) 2 times = 8
- Crochet sc to a new position to the left side of the leg. Fill the foot with fiberfill in the front, flatten it and crochet it together with 4 sc.
- Round 7: Ch 1, 4 sc in the front loop, turn, 4 sc in the back loop = 8
- Round 8-16: 1 sc in each st around = 8 (64 in total)
- Crochet sc to a new position to the left side of the leg. Fill the leg with fiberfill, flatten it and crochet it together with 4 sc.
- For the first leg: Cut the thread, pull it through the last st and put aside for later.
- For the second leg: Don't cut the thread but continue with the body.

### Body

- Round 1: Crochet around: In the front loop: Ch 1, 4 sc from the first leg, 4 sc from the second, turn, in the back loop: 4 sc from the second leg, 4 sc from the first leg = 16
- Round 2: 1 sc, (2 sc in the next st) 6 times, 9 sc = 22
- Round 3-5: 1 sc in each st around = 22 (88 in total)
- Crochet sc to position to the side of the body.

- Round 6: 9 sc, (2 sc in the next st) 6 times, 1 sc = 16

Now it is time to attach the arms to the body. They should be attached on the three st at each side of the body.

- Round 7: 7 sc, 3 sc through the arm and the body, 5 sc, 3 sc arm and body = 18
- Crochet 2 extra sc to a new position at the side of the body.
- Round 8: (1 sc, 2 sc tog) 5 times = 10
- Round 9: (2 sc tog, 3 sc) 2 times, 3 sc = 8
- Crochet 3 extra sc to position at the back of the body and continue with the head.

### Head

- Round 9: In the front loop: (2 sc in the next st) 8 times = 16
- Crochet sc to a new position at the side of the head.
- Round 10: (2 sc in the next st, 8 sc) 2 times = 18
- Round 11-15: 1 sc in each st around = 18 (48 in total)
- Fill the body and the major part of the head with fiberfill.
- Round 16: (1 sc, 2 sc tog) 6 times = 12
- Fill the rest of the head.
- Round 17: (2 sc tog) 6 times = 6
- 1 sl st. Fill the rest of the head and finish off.

### Nose

- Round 1: Ch 3, 1 sc in the 2nd ch from the hook, 1 sc, crochet around on the other side 2 sc = 4
- Round 2: (2 sc in the next st, 1 sc) 2 times = 6
- Round 3: (2 sc in the next st, 2 sc) 2 times = 8
- Round 4: (2 sc in the next st, 3 sc) 2 times = 10
- 1 sl st, cut the thread and sew the nose on to the head beginning at the throat.

### Ear (crochet in rows)

- Row 1: Ch 7, 1 sc in the 2nd ch from the hook, 4 sc, 3 sc in the next st, 5 sc = 13
- Row 2: 5 sc, (2 sc in the next st) 3 times, 5 sc = 16
- Row 3: 1 sl st in each st around.
- Fold in the middle and sew it onto the head.

Embroider the nose, eyes and details as in the picture.
